

TAP TRAINING COURSE PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- HAVE YOU PRE-REGISTERED? DUE TO CDC DIRECTIVES, ALASKA CHARR IS LIMITING THE AMOUNT OF TRAINEES TO ENSURE SOCIAL DISTANCING. IF YOU DID NOT PRE-REGISTER PLEASE CHECK FOR THE NEXT SCHEDULED CLASS AND PRE-REGISTER.
- NO PERSONNEL HAVE BEEN IN THE TRAINING ROOM FOR AT LEAST (5) DAYS
- NO ACTIVITY HAS TAKEN PLACE IN THE TRAINING ROOM FOR AT LEAST (5) DAYS
- HAVE YOU DISPLAYED ANY SYMPTOMS DESCRIBED IN CDC GUIDELINES (PLEASE SEE CHART BELOW) IN THE PAST 14 DAYS? ANY TRAINEE DISPAYING SYMPTONS WILL BE ASKED TO RESCHEDULE.
- UPON ENTERING THE CLASSROOM, PLEASE PUT YOUR ID/DRIVER'S LICENSE ON THE BACK TABLE AND FIND YOUR ASSIGNED SEAT. THE INSTRUCTOR WILL CHECK YOUR ID AND WILL INFORM YOU WHEN TO RETRIEVE IT. IT IS RECOMMENDED TO WASH YOUR HANDS PRIOR TO SITTING FOR THE CLASS.
- YOUR CLASS MATERIALS (TAP CARRICULUM BOOK AND PEN) WILL BE AT YOUR SEAT. THE INSTRUCTOR WILL HAVE USED NEW NITRILE GLOVES PRIOR TO HANDLING THE MATERIALS.
- ONE PAIR OF NITRILE GLOVES WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOU IF YOU DO NOT HAVE ANY.
- SEATING IS SPACED IN ACCORDANCE TO COVID-19 SOCIAL DISTANCING AND TRAINEES SHOULD MINIMIZE MOVING FROM THEIR SEAT. IF YOUR NEED A DIFFERENT SEAT TO SEE OR HEAR THE PRESENTATION, LET THE INSTRUCTOR KNOW AND HE/SHE WILL ACCOMMODATE YOUR REQUEST.
- PLEASE PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING FROM THE TRAINER AND OTHER TRAINEES.
