



JUNEAU ANIMAL RESCUE

On Tuesday October 4, 2022, Juneau Animal Rescue (JAR) will be hosting the Alaska Cabaret, Hotel, Restaurant & Retailers Association (CHARR) auction during the 2022 CHARR convention in Juneau, Alaska. Supporters will be able to bid on items in an online silent auction a week prior to the event, and attendees of the auction event will have the opportunity to participate in a live auction. We are asking for your support by donating an item for this year's auction.

Juneau Animal Rescue is a private, non-profit animal shelter in Juneau, Alaska. The shelter was founded in 1963 by members of the community who collaborated to help disadvantaged and homeless animals. Throughout the years, we have grown to provide shelter, care, and services for thousands of animals. We are currently working to meet the unique demands resulting from a lack of veterinarians. While this is a nationwide problem, it is especially felt in the Last Frontier. In Juneau, a handful of vets provide care for approximately 70,000 animals. As a result, JAR has become the main provider of animal vaccinations in the community. We have also seen an unprecedented increase in the number of unwanted litters relinquished to the shelter.

Juneau Animal Rescue's mission is:

- To serve our community by promoting animal welfare and strengthening the animal-human bond.
- To improve the lives of pets through education and protection.
- To shelter stray, abandoned, and surrendered pets and find them loving homes.

Each and every year we:

- Provide adoptive homes for over 400 animals
- Provide Animal Control & Protection Services for the City and Borough of Juneau
- Return over 300 lost or stray animals to their owners
- Board more than 2,500 dogs
- Provide daycare for over 3,000 dogs
- Work on over 1,500 animal control & protection cases
- License approximately 4,000 dogs

- Overnight boarding for Dogs
- Doggy Day Care
- Grooming (self-service)
- Weekly low-cost vaccination & microchip clinics
- Specialty pet products and food
- Classroom speakers
- Volunteer opportunities

- Low-cost spay/neuter services for low-income individuals
