

# Legislative Update



## This Week In Juneau

The FY24 budget dominated most of this week in the legislature, with most all House committee hearings being canceled so that the floor sessions could run all day. The House worked through around 100 amendments to the FY24 operating budget. The main amendment to the budget was the inclusion of an additional \$175 million of funding for K12 education. The final debate and vote on the budget have been slated for this coming Monday, April 10.

In anticipation of the FY24 budget moving from the House to the Senate, the Senate Finance subcommittees are beginning the close-out process for department budgets. The full Senate Finance Committee will begin working on the budget next week after final passage in the House.
